Assessment methods: <i>During the semester, there will be one written test, in which students may score 30 points. Assessment: A: 24 points, B: 18 points, C: 12 points, D: 6 points, E: 5 points. Credits will not be awarded to students who will score less than 5 points in the written test. At the end of the semester during the examination period: Exam. Final grading: achieved average.</i>	
Learning outcomes of the course unit: <i>After the course completion, students will gain an overview of the basic concepts of crisis management on crisis prevention, crisis situations and phenomena and their division. The course will provide students with an overview of the institutions and bodies of crisis management and the role of individual components of the Integrated Rescue System (IRS). Student will know the scope and role of central government authorities especially the Ministry of Internal Affairs and the Ministry of Health, district offices and emergency responders - basic, other departments and police force and the causes of the crisis in the economic field and in the public sector. Students will understand the issue of crisis management, issues and areas of economic mobilization and economic security of the state defense and information system issues in crisis management. After successful course completion, students will be able to do the analysis and evaluation focused on the status and ability of management to manage the affairs of government in crisis situations, the IRS components for action in crisis situations and to assess the adequacy of IRS forces equipment and assets in the comparison within the V4 countries and selected EU countries.</i>
