In the course of the semester will be assessed active participation, preparation of the required task (presentation EU in Italian). Credit will be granted to a student who from one test gave less than 15 points. At the end of the semester during the examination period: Credit. Final evaluation: progress diameter.

Learning outcomes of the course unit:

A student completing the course gain expert knowledge in the field of foreign history of the European Union, its institutions and bodies, corporate governance, companies, non-profit organizations, meetings, negotiations and cultural specifics.
