The student should be able to use basic terminology and basic economic categories used in finance and funding at the level of the business, public sector, international finance. The student should to understand financial relations of currency circulation and currency, to understand financial market issues, to orientate in banking and banking system and international finance. After successful completion of this course the student should be ready to pass objects that are directly linked to the subject Finance and Currency in the next university studies.</i>
