#### **Assessment Methods:**

Successful completion of practical state exams according to the study programme of ADU of Trenčín.

If the Commission evaluates the practical part of the state examination as "poorly" -FX (requires further work), a student cannot continue in the other parts of the state exam.

## **Learning Outcomes of the Course:**

The graduates of the study field of Physiotherapy  $-1^{st}$  level, have knowledge of basic examination and treatment procedures and methods in physiotherapy, balneology and medical rehabilitation. They are ready to independently perform activities requiring professional erudition, are independent at work and in decision-making, bear personal responsibility in medical rehabilitation, primary, secondary and in in primary, secondary and tertiary health care, preventive, diagnostic, therapeutic, counselling and educational activities. They perform basic techniques, methodologies, physiotherapy procedures and performances, basic physiatric and balneology methods and performances, hydrotherapy, occupational therapy, electrotherapy, and kinesiology.

#### **Course Contents:**

- 1. Complex physiotherapy in patients with impaired functioning (disability) related to the musculoskeletal system.
- 2. Complex physiotherapy in patients on orthopaedic department and the department of traumatology.
- 3. Complex physiotherapy in unconscious patients.
- 4. Complex physiotherapy in patients with patients with central nervous system disorders.
- 5. Complex physiotherapy in patients with impairment of the peripheral nervous system.
- 6. Complex physiotherapy in patients with impaired cardiopulmonary and cardiovascular system.
- 7. Complex physiotherapy in patients with gastrointestinal complications.
- 8. Complex physiotherapy in patients with hematopoietic and endocrine disorders.
- 9. Complex physiotherapy in patients with urinary tract obstruction renal dysfunction.
