Assessment methods:

Active participation in seminars (independent preparation on discussions according to instructions of lecturer and participation in discussions), continuous short written analysis of actual events and final presentation of selected portfolio. Continuous assessment: active participation (not more than 2 allowed absences) and short presentation 20%. Final presentation of portfolio: 80%.

Instructions for portfolio: Selection of works of discourse analysis prepared during whole semester. It is not possible to get credits without active participation in lectures and discussions during semester.

## Learning outcomes of the course unit:

By completing the course student has knowledge about theoretical basics of social protocol and its realization in practice. He/she recognizes the consequences of human behavior in society and also the importance of knowledge of its dimension and need of good human relations. He is familiarized with the social protocol in different situations and he/she uses it as a tool which helps to develop social skills in the realm of communication.

- 11. Argumentation, persuasiveness, stereotypes and prejudices.

12. Presentations of students' works. Discussion and self-image.

13. Presentations of students' works and evaluation.
