Learning outcomes of the course unit: <i>Students learn basic terms from the area of international relations and diplomacy. They get acquainted with history of diplomacy, problematic of so-called public diplomacy and system of state bodies focused on the formation of foreign policy. The further seminars focus on the practical facts of diplomacy such as functioning of diplomatic missions, consular service and diplomatic protocol. The aims of this course is to teach students about basic methods of analysis of foreign policy.</i>

Diplomatic etiquettes. 5. Diplomatic correspondence. 6. Types of diplomatic relations. 7. Protocol of state bodies in international relations. 8. Diplomatic protocol SR and EU. 9. Course of diplomatic missions. 10. International conferences and acts. 11. Dining etiquettes and evening wear. 12. International agreements about diplomatic and consular relations. 13. Final seminar.</i>
