Learning outcomes of the course unit:

This course **provides** students basics of rhetoric with regard to its using in political science occupation; **information** about the mission of rhetoric. It puts emphasis on verbal and non-verbal communication, oral presentation, rhetoric, choice of words. Analysis of famous political speech in seminars: improvement of rhetorical skills (writing of speech and its presentation).

Course contents:

- 1. Term and history of rhetoric I. Ancient Greece and Rome.
- 2. Term and history of rhetoric II. Middle Ages and Renaissance.
- 3. Classification of speech.
- 4. Language, speech, communication (relationships among them).
- 5. Verbal communication.
- 6. Non-verbal communication (gestures, facial expressions).
- 7. Breathing, creation of voices, pronunciation, intonation, pace)
- 8. Psychotherapy of stage fright, negatives, positives, own evaluation.
- 9. Personality of speaker.
- 10. Ethics, culture and technique of speech.
- 11. Rhetoric as a tool of political activity.
- *12. Speaker and listener their mutual relationship.*
- 13. Presentation, lecture, discussion.
